### Getting in the Habit


- Most people haven't developed a video habit

## Top Shooting Tips


- \* Set white balance & trust auto settings
- **Capture clips of approx 10 sec**
- 🜟 Roll before things happen. Continue after they end.
- to use few camera movements let action come to you

\* Establish framing & composition right away - instinct rule of 3rds
