UPPER LEFT: The *Rotterdam Dining Room* is a two-tiered dining venue that provides one of the finest dining experiences at sea, offering everything from continental cuisine to vegetarian and low-carb options. UPPER RIGHT: Take a brisk walk on the teak *Promenade Deck* or just relax with an afternoon cocktail. The ships also have basketball courts and practice tennis courts where you can hone your game under the wide-open sky.

MIDDLE RIGHT: The reservations-only *Pinnacle Grill*, renowned for its Sterling Silver Beef and Bvlgari® china, ensures an extraordinary dining experience by providing two servers per table. In the *ms Ryndam* you'll find a monumental marble fountain, much like you'd find in a Roman piazza. And the *ms Veendam* is home to a blue and gold crystalline glass tower. Each of these magnificent installations is as breathtaking as it is unique.

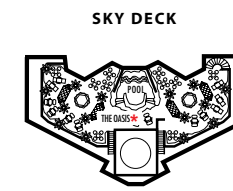
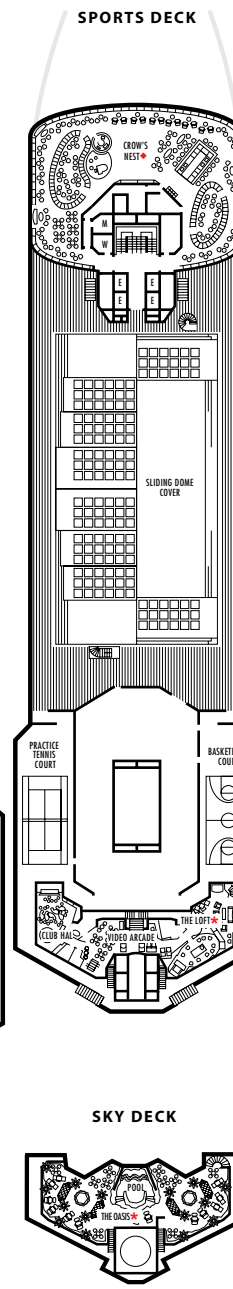
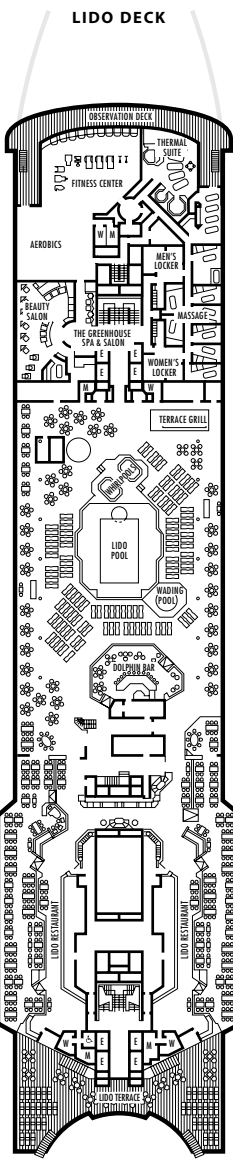
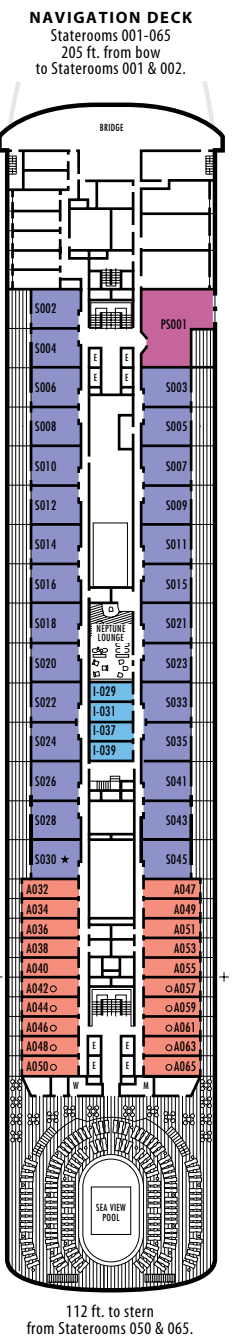
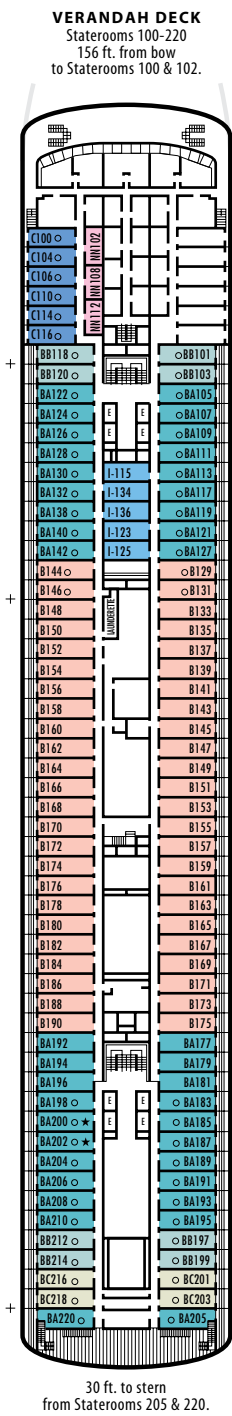
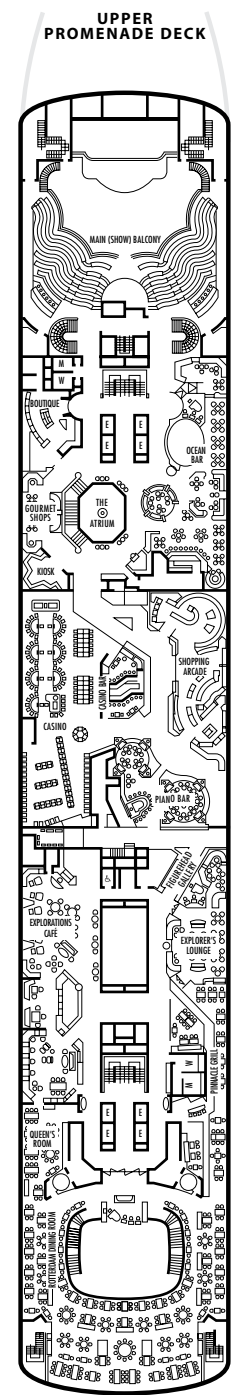
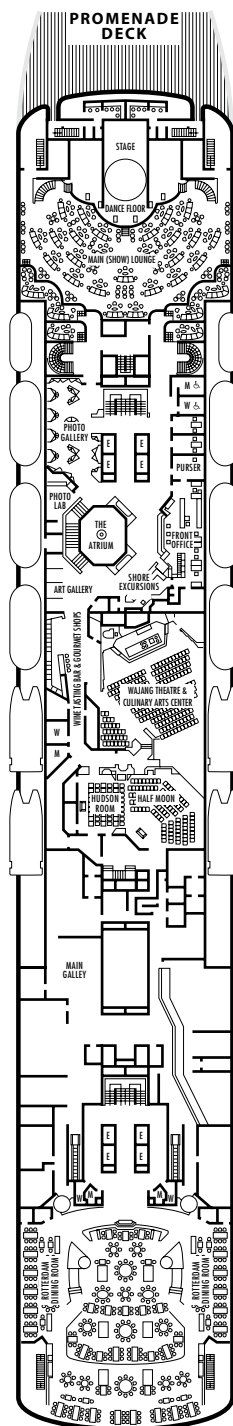
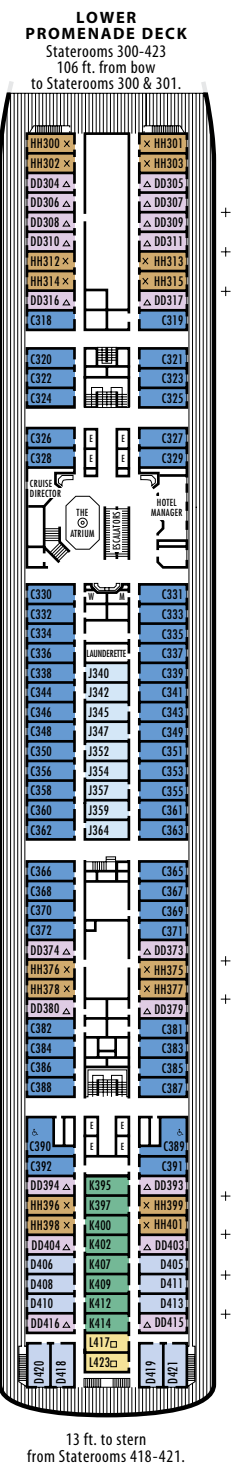
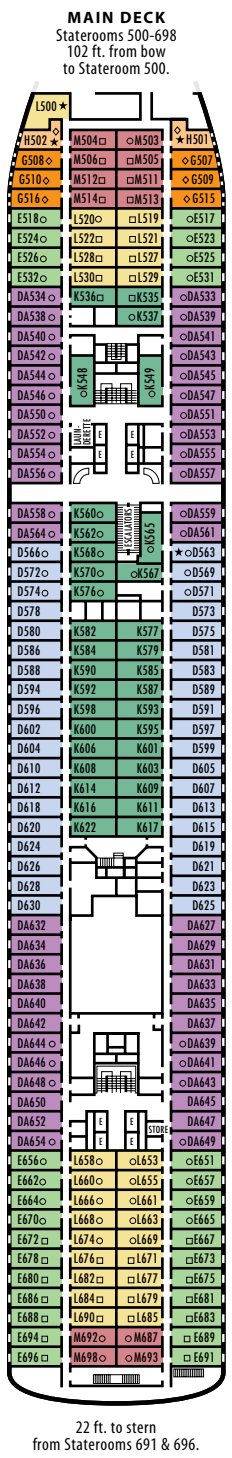
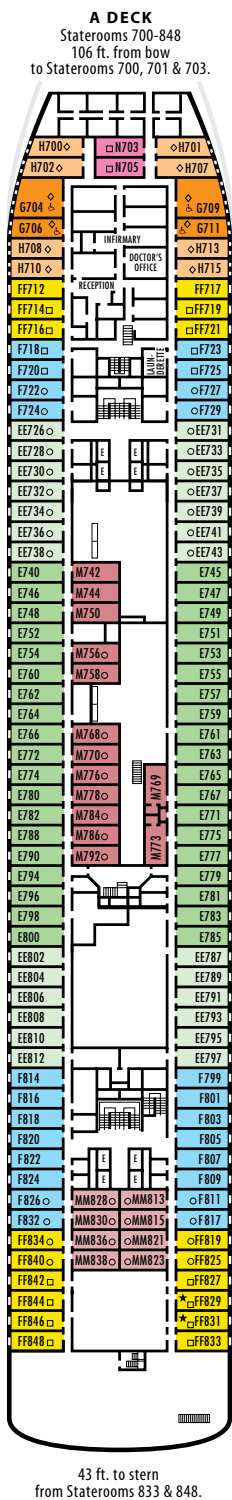
BOTTOM, LEFT TO RIGHT: The *Explorer's Lounge* provides a comfortable after-dinner atmosphere for enjoying hand-dipped chocolates and specialty coffee drinks. Live classical music creates a tasteful ambiance while our skilled crew caters to your every preference.

The *Culinary Arts Center*—presented by *Food & Wine* magazine—is a dream come true for food lovers, cooks and epicureans. 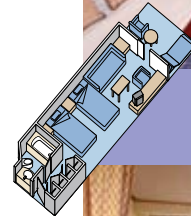
PENTHOUSE VERANDAH SUITE
approx. 1,159 sq. ft. with verandah



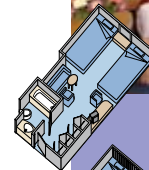
DELUXE VERANDAH SUITE
