## ➤ frequently asked questions



### what should i wear?

Comfortable walking shoes are recommended for all shore excursions. When you visit places of worship, we recommend dressing conservatively (no shorts or sleeveless tops), but casual clothing is perfectly acceptable. Dress in layers and have a jacket along. Bring an umbrella or raincoat, a hat and sunscreen.

### what about meals?

Most tour departures complement the ship's meal service hours. In-room dining is available on board.

### how will i know what time each tour departs?

The on-board Shore Excursions Order Form in your stateroom will show departure times. This information will also be printed on your shore excursion tickets, which you will receive on board. Approximate tour departure times are posted on our website at [www.hollandamerica.com](http://www.hollandamerica.com).

### i have a disability. how do i know which tours will best suit me? will i have a problem (dis)embarking the ship?

Guests with disabilities should inquire in advance whether a shore excursion will be able to accommodate their needs. We have graded the Shore Excursions according to the relative level of activity they entail. The walking icons that appear at the beginning of each tour description provide a general idea of the level of activity to expect. Please refer to the "How to Choose Your Tours" section in this brochure for specific information on the walking icons. It is important to keep in mind that shore excursion operators are subject to the laws of their own country including with respect to accommodating the needs of guests with disabilities. In most foreign countries, the laws are not as stringent as those in the United States. Please speak with the Shore Excursions Office as to whether you can expect to encounter difficulties (dis)embarking the ship in a particular port of call. In this regard, the decision whether or not to carry or provide other mobility assistance to a guest and their mobility assistance device (wheelchair, walker, etc.) up or down a ship's gangway, or on or off a tender boat, is at the sole discretion of the Captain,

made based on his evaluation of guest and crew safety.

We encourage you to bring a collapsible wheelchair as space limitations may restrict the ability of some tour operators to accommodate motorized mobility aid devices.

### i am traveling with friends and we would like to be on the same motor coach

The departure location for each shore excursion is printed on your shore excursion tickets. If you wish to travel with friends, please arrive at the designated meeting place together. This will enable the staff to allocate space for you on the same vehicle.

### tour durations

The individual tour descriptions include approximate durations. To allow our Shore Excursions Managers flexibility to coordinate your time in port with meals and activities on the ship, exact departure times are published in the Shore Excursions Order Form on board. For more information, please attend the Shore Excursions Presentation or visit the Shore Excursions Office.

### tour descriptions

## ➤ book your shore excursions online

Book online now, up until three days before sailing. Make your payment online via our secure website, and receive confirmation as well as your approximate tour departure times. You can also download the shore excursions, view tour prices, find answers to frequently asked questions and read general information.

Remember, online shore excursion reservations are processed prior to any requests made on board the ship and receive priority handling.

### general information for booking online

At the time of making your reservations online, we will advise you whether or not your reservations are confirmed or whether you have been waitlisted. Your credit card will be charged immediately for all confirmed reservations. Should space become available for a waitlisted shore excursion request, we will e-mail or otherwise contact you at that time and either immediately charge your credit card if you have already given us your credit card information or ask you to provide us with that information for immediate charge processing. Shore excursion reservations are subject to cancellation by us at any time prior to the credit card charge being accepted by your bank. If you or Holland America cancel a tour more than 3 days prior to cruise departure, we will issue a credit on the credit card that you used to pay for the reservation. For any cancellation within 3 days of departure, a credit will not be given on your credit card. Instead, we will apply an ONBOARD CREDIT ONLY policy under which the refund (less any cancellation fee) will show up as a credit to the shipboard account of the person who was to take the shore excursion. If the credit is not fully utilized during the cruise, the balance will be paid to that guest by the ship's Purser.

## ➤ how to choose your tours



Choose your shore excursions by using these icons as a general guide to the level of activity involved, and select the shore excursions best suited to your physical capabilities.



**easy activity:** Very light activity including short distances to walk; may include some steps.



**moderate activity:** Requires intermittent effort throughout, including walking medium distances over uneven surfaces and/or steps.



**strenuous activity:** Requires active participation, walking long distances over uneven and steep terrain or on steps. In certain instances, paddling or other non-walking activity is required and guests must be able to participate without discomfort or difficulty breathing.



**panoramic:** Specially designed for guests who enjoy a slower pace, these excursions offer sightseeing mainly from the transportation vehicle, with few or no stops, and no mandatory disembarkation during the tour. As vehicles outside the USA are rarely lift-equipped and ramps are seldom available, a very small amount of walking will be necessary. The pace will be gentle and taking your time is encouraged.



**limited capacity:** The number of people able to participate in this tour is strictly limited. Reasons for limiting capacity may include the number of transportation seats available, or to maintain a safe ratio of guides for hikes, fishing and water activities. Tours require a minimum number of participants to operate.

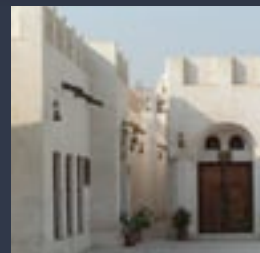


**meal:** This tour includes a meal—lunch on daytime tours, or dinner on evening tours.

**about the transportation:** Each type of transportation will be of the highest grade available in that port. Not all modes of transportation are available in all locations. **pricing:** The cost of each type of transportation will be published online at [www.hollandamerica.com](http://www.hollandamerica.com).

**also included:** The cost includes the service of a driver and English-speaking guide, unlimited mileage, road tolls, parking fees and bottled water.

**not included (unless otherwise noted):** Guests' entrance fees for attractions are not included in the price due to the wide range of attraction possibilities, uncertain number of attractions to be visited, and varying number of guests participating. We strongly

recommend that you bring some local currency to cover such costs as credit cards are not readily accepted in some ports. Lunch will not be included on any tour as many guests prefer to select their own dining venue.

**itinerary planning:** If you need help planning your personal itinerary, the Port Lecturer and/or Shore Excursions Manager can assist you and will gladly answer your questions. This can be very helpful in many destinations where travel time, location, holidays, and opening hours of attractions need to be taken into consideration in order to maximize the efficiency of your time ashore.

**online reservations:** The fastest and easiest way for you to reserve and pay for your Signature Collection experience is on the Holland America Line website. Please note the cost will be per mode of transportation (not per person), so only one person in the party needs to make the reservation. The price shown on the website is the total cost for the transportation, driver and guide (not a per-person price). In many ports, availability is extremely limited. **payment & tour vouchers:** Your credit card will be charged after your reservation is confirmed. Next, start planning what you'll do with your Signature Collection experience in each port. On board the ship, you will be given a form to advise the Shore Excursions Office of the itinerary you have chosen.

**booking on board:** The Signature Collection may be available for booking once you are on the ship, but this cannot be guaranteed. Please check with the Shore Excursions Office on board.

**disembarking the ship:** In some disembarkation ports, a private vehicle and guide can be used for sightseeing en route to the airport. When booking, please advise the total amount of luggage for your party. Size of vehicle and luggage space may limit the number of guests in the vehicle.

### Aqua Trax Adventure

Experience Half Moon Cay from the natural inner saltwater lagoon on a guided personal watercraft adventure. After a short tram ride, you'll arrive at the safety briefing area and have time to get used to your personal sit-on watercraft. Depart single file with a lead guide and another guide bringing up the rear. Traveling along the picturesque shoreline of the island you'll navigate around the natural reef formations, inlets, islands and sand spits before stopping for a cool drink. Buoyed courses will allow you to test your watercraft skills. With your guide, you'll briefly stop at the tidal outlet, the Indian village and Stingray Cove.

Please note: Minimum age is 16. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

### Eco Lagoon Cruise

Board a boat with glass-bottom viewers and cross the lagoon, as you learn about Half Moon Cay and Bahamian history, culture, flora and fauna. Stingrays, nurse sharks, lemon sharks, bonefish, conch, sea urchins and assorted marine life are raised here. Half Moon Cay is also an official sanctuary for birdwatching. Through the boat's glass floor, discover a series of living reefs, where fish, coral and anemones are plentiful.

Please note: This tour is not recommended for guests who suffer from motion sickness.

### Eco-Bike and Hike Tour



Departs: 10:15 AM, 11:45 AM, 1:45 PM  
Approximately 1 ½ Hours  
Price \$37.00

After a safety briefing, set out with your guide on a bike ride that shows you the “back of the house.” This behind-the-scenes glimpse of Half Moon Cay takes you past the staff housing units, offices, reverse-osmosis water plant, electrical generator, incinerator, bilge water processing plant, recycling center, maintenance and fabrication shop. Next, you will pass Half Moon Cay Marina and the dining pavilion on the way to Pegasus Ranch, where you will take a brief rest. Remount your bike for a short ride to the seaplane landing area for refreshments. You’ll leave your bike behind as your hike begins here. Keep an eye out for birds that are occasionally seen here, such as the Bahamas mocking bird, wood dove, white crown pigeon, tobacco dove, Cuban finch, banana bird, poor Joe and burrowing owl. Climb the ridge, which boasts a first-stage lookout with an awesome view of Bone Fish Lagoon, Stingray Park and the Water Sports Rental Center. You’ll find yourself standing on the foundation ruins of a limestone dwelling from the 1700s. The vegetation in this area are trees of Madeira bark, pigeon plum, wild tamarind, Bahamian hardwoods, sapodilla, camalamy bark, seven-year apple, silver buttonwood, love vine and sisal cactus. The latter is used for rope making. Cross over a dividing wall that is hundreds of years old. On the other side you will pass additional ruins en route to the eastern lookout. Here

you will see magnificent views of the eastern tip of Half Moon Cay, Goat Cay, Long Rocks and Cat Island, some 18 miles away. Wind your way back westward on the north face of the ridge. There are two ponds here, one brackish and one saltwater. Early settlers worked the salt pond to harvest salt for trading. Follow the path down to a freshwater well used by pirates. You’ll step through an amazing patch of lovely native orchids. Continue to the main area of ruins where remnants of many limestone structures lie. The western tip of the island can be seen from here. The view includes the Island of Eleuthera and the your cruise ship. You will continue through a cactus patch leading down a narrow footpath back to the lagoon.

Please note: Minimum weight is 80 lbs; maximum weight is 225 lbs. Minimum age is 10 years; maximum age is 80 years. Minimum height is 5 feet; maximum height is 7 feet. Wear shorts, a t-shirt and aqua shoes, sneakers or sandals.

### Eco-Walk and Bike Tour

Approximately 1 ½ Hours

Your informative guide will walk with you along a path that meanders past a pond. Seasonal inhabitants here include local species of wildlife such as egrets, coots, Bahamas ducks, herons and diver ducks. You will walk across a bed of crab holes where the white crab buries itself during the day, coming out to feed at night. These crabs are hunted by the natives and are considered a delicacy when cooked with rice. Silver buttonwood trees abound near the water’s

edge. Their intricate root system creates a great deal of driftwood. Other indigenous trees, poisonwood, pigeon plum, torchwood and thatch palms line both sides of the trail. Three different vantage points along the walk allow views of the “back of the house,” where the heart of the island’s operations are located. Your guide will brief you about the operations of the island staff residences, cafeteria, gym, recreation room, maintenance shop, fabrication shop, reverse-osmosis water plant, electrical generating plant, incinerator plant, and island telecommunications. This is a 15-minute walk, which ends at the Island Nursery—an eco-friendly facility irrigated by a natural spring. Composted materials from seaweed and landscaping are used as a natural fertilizer. Groves of coconut and palm trees are grown for transplanting throughout the island. The vegetable patch has a sample of local vegetables and herbs. Citrus trees such as lime, sour orange, and grapefruit produce fruit for juice, marinades, and dressing. The chicken coop provides free-range eggs that are harvested daily from chickens fed with corn raised on the island’s farm. A mulching machine mills fallen tree limbs collected from around the property. A limekiln cooks conch shells to make lime the way early settlers did. The lime is used to sanitize the walls of the rock abodes. Remnants of these dwellings can be viewed on the next leg of your tour at the ruins. You will get a firsthand look into the local methods of planting seedlings, clippings and mossing, which produces the various plantlife that is raised and transplanted around the Cay. A 15-minute walk along a ridge with an elevation of 20 to 50 feet overlooks the Nursery and the Stingray Park and ends at Bone Fish Lagoon. From this location, you will see ruins of four limestone houses dating back to the time when loyalist

settlers inhabited the Bahamian Isles during the 1700s. Native trees such as wild tamarind, sapodilla, love vine, five fingers, camalamy, sisal cactuses, Madeira bark, cabbage palms, seven-year apple, and sea grapes are in abundance throughout this walk. Birds occasionally seen here include the Bahamas mocking bird, white crown pigeon, tobacco dove, Cuban finch, banana bird, poor Joe and burrowing owl. The ridge portion of the tour ends at the bicycle depot, where a bottle of cold water or soda awaits you. Select your helmet and bicycle and listen to a safety briefing. Then jump on your bike and take a 15-minute bicycle ride up the Bone Fish Trail to Stingray Park, down past the Island Nursery and Tropic Restaurant and capturing gorgeous view of the beach. Your ride continues to Pegasus Ranch, home of the swimming horses. Enjoy a brief rest stop at the ranch then coast down to the seaplane landing and Bone Fish Lagoon, where your bike ride ends.

Please note: Minimum weight is 50 lbs; maximum weight is 225 lbs. Minimum age is 10 years; maximum age is 80 years. Wear shorts, a t-shirt, and aqua shoes, sneakers or sandals that you don’t mind getting wet.

### Eco-Walk and Kayak Tour

Your informative guide will walk with you along a path that meanders past a pond. Seasonal inhabitants here include local species of wildlife such as egrets, coots, Bahamas ducks, herons and diver ducks. You will walk across a bed of crab holes where the

Birds occasionally seen here include the Bahamas mocking bird, white crown pigeon, tobacco dove, Cuban finch, banana bird, poor Joe and burrowing owl. Then, after a safety briefing, select your life vest and kayak. You'll set out with your guide on a 25-minute ride along the perimeter of the western edge of the inner lagoon. The route of this kayak ride scoots past the protected mangrove species that play a huge role in the habitat formation for all kinds of marine life in this lagoon. The intricate root structure of the mangroves allows juvenile fish to survive where predators cannot reach them. The sea floor has turtle grass and a sandy bottom. Along the northwest quadrant of the lagoon, the rocky shoreline offers a vertical view as the limestone rock reaches more than 80 feet in height. Head eastward along this shoreline and across to the southern coast close to the Stingray Park, returning your kayak to Water Sports Rental Center # 3.

Please note: Minimum weight is 80 lbs; maximum weight is 225 lbs. Minimum age is 10 years; maximum age is 80 years. Minimum height is 5 feet; maximum height is 7 feet. Wear shorts, a t-shirt, and aqua shoes, sneakers or sandals.

Traveling 90 minutes through Jamaica's beautiful countryside, you will pass many historic sites and villages on the way, to Dunn's River Falls. Dunn's River Falls is believed to be the site of the famous Battle of Las Chorreras, fought in 1657 between the Spanish and the English. A stake was possession of the island of Jamaica. Needless to say, the English won and the course of history was set. Under British rule, Las Chorreras was first owned by Charles Pryce. It later became part of the 276-acre Belmont property and was acquired by the Jamaican Government in 1972 for development of recreational and park facilities. Today, Dunn's River Falls can best be described as a living and growing phenomenon, the waterfall continuously regenerates itself from deposits of travertine rock—the result of calcium carbonate found in the river. The small dome-shaped cataracts (falls) are usually associated with thermal spring activity found in limestone caves. Experience the thrill of climbing the waterfall, in a human chain manned by experienced guides. Pause at the “massage parlor” and experience the soothing effects of the water as it cascades over the rocks and down to the sea. Less adventurous folks can view the activities of the intrepid from the vantage point of the terrace or the viewing deck. Enjoy nature's gifts as you lose yourself in the lush tropical foliage of ferns, bamboos, ginger lilies, crotons, orchids, a variety of palms and breadfruit trees.

Please note: Lockers are available for rent at Dunn's River Falls. Wear aqua shoes or bring a pair with you if you choose to climb Dunn's River Falls. Please be advised that the Falls can be very slippery in places. Jumping from the falls is not permitted. Wear your swimsuit under your clothing; bring a towel, sunscreen and a hat. Leave valuables (such as jewelry) in a secure location on board the ship.

### Highlights of Falmouth & Greenwood Great House

The Barrett's of Wimpole Street fame came to Jamaica in the 1660s and amassed great wealth from their sugar plantations. In 1790, they created the village of Falmouth, built on seaside land owned by Edward Moulton Barrett, grandfather of famed English Romantic poet Elizabeth Barrett Browning. Elizabeth Barrett Browning was bequeathed the family's Falmouth holdings called Greenwood, giving her much needed financial independence. Greenwood Great House is one of the finest antique museums in the Caribbean and indeed the “greatest” Great House in Jamaica. Built during an era of strangely blended elegance and brutality, Greenwood has retained the atmosphere of the 19th century and continues to capture the imagination of its visitors. The home still has much of its original furniture, with a well-preserved library, a grand ballroom, oil paintings, a rare collection of musical instruments and antiques. Falmouth's fortunes as a commercial center declined after the emancipation of slaves in the British Empire, starting in 1840. Present-day

Falmouth is a relic, as are many parish capitals in Jamaica. Yet, people from all over the north coast flock to its very popular Wednesday “Bend-Down Market.” The town’s buildings, old and not-so-old, make up the historic townscape of Falmouth. These shared characteristics weave the varied building styles into a distinctive pattern of early Jamaican architecture, and a large representation of each variety makes the town very distinctive. At night, Glistening Waters, also known as the Luminous Lagoon, boasts a singular charm—it glows an eerie green when the water is disturbed. The green glow is due to the presence of bioluminescent microorganisms.

## The White Witch of Rose Hall

Born in France, she was a petite woman (around four feet tall) who moved to the beautiful island of Jamaica to be the wife of a powerful man who owned Rose Hall and thousands of acres of sugar plantation. Annie Palmer reputedly had three husbands during her reign as mistress of the Rose Hall Plantation and each of them died a sudden and violent death. The slaves who worked on the plantation believed Annie murdered them. Although she maintained her innocence, she gained a reputation for cruelty and, with it, her unappealing nickname. It is said that she pined for the bright lights of Paris, and found life on the island to be a hardship. Annie took out her frustrations on the slaves who lived and worked on the plantation. She ruled with an iron fist. Defiance or perceived insolence resulted in public whippings, torture in the dungeon, and even death. You will learn more about the White Witch of Rose Hall during your tour and taste the exotic Witches Brew—a mixed drink named after the infamous Annie. Departing Rose Hall, you will see residential homes of diverse architecture in the Spring Farm and Ironshore area. Drive through the town of Montego Bay by way of the Hip Strip and past Doctor's Cave Beach—

once the playground for the rich and famous. Your guide will point out landmarks such as the Casa Blanca, one of the first hotels in Montego Bay. Pause for shopping at City Centre Duty Free to browse for that perfect souvenir that will remind you of your visit to Jamaica.

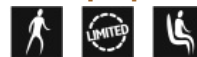

### about pricing, refunds & cancellations:

Rates and descriptions are current as of the printing date. Prices are subject to change without notice and descriptions may vary from the actual tour provided. All cancellations that are made less than 5 days prior to cruise departure are subject to a 10% cancellation fee. There will be no exceptions. In addition, if you cancel your tour reservation after the booking deadline stated in the Shore Excursion Planning Form on board, or if you cancel a Signature Collection private vehicle tour, a 100% cancellation fee will apply since transportation and services will have already been arranged.

### cancellation of overland adventures and overnight tours:

The cancellation policy for Overland Adventures and Overnight Tours is (with no exceptions):

- 30 days before tour date: 25% penalty
- 14 days before tour date: 50% penalty
- Within 14 days: non-refundable
