Tea at Reid's (Ref: FNC_002)

Madeira

En route to Reid's Hotel, you will enjoy a scenic drive to the viewpoint of Pico dos Barcelos for magnificent views over Funchal.

Built in the last century, Reid's Palace has always had a special place in the history of Madeira. Located on the outskirts of Funchal, perched on a cliff top headland overlooking the bay, Reid's is set in ten acres of lush semi tropical gardens, where hanging vines jostle for room with stunning displays of geraniums, hibiscus and salvias.

Upon arrival, you will be taken on a short walk through the Hotel gardens before tea is served, giving you an opportunity to relax and enjoy the unique atmosphere.

The menu includes tea, scones and cakes.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach and on foot. The ground at the viewpoint is flat and cobbled, and the walk in the Hotel garden is over uneven ground with approximately 20 steps. There is a strict dress code at Reid's. Jeans, t-shirts, shorts, sports shoes or sandals are not permitted. Flat walking shoes are recommended. Tea will be served in a separate, private dining area.

Eco City Tour, Tukxi Madeira (Ref: FNC_039)

Madeira

Originating in Italy, Ape Calessino tukxi's are 3 – wheeler modern day versions of the 'little cart' that was popular with the 1950's 'Dolce Vita' lifestyle. Having now expanded into other parts of Europe this method of transport re-creates the true meaning of Dolce Vita – The good life, full of pleasure and indulgence.

On your intimate guided tour you can sit back and admire the scenery as your driver heads along the harbour front, which has views of the sea on one side and clusters of houses on green mountains on the other. Arriving in the Old Town you'll travel along the narrow cobbled streets, which are lined with beautifully restored houses and quaint local restaurants, contrasting with the wider and busier Avenida Arriaga, the city's main commercial centre. Along the way look out for colourful local ladies (dressed in traditional costume), selling the famous 'bird of paradise', the true symbol of the island. Right in the heart of the city is the delightful Praca do Municipio, the awe inspiring square that boasts the architectural treasure of City Hall.


As well as discovering the hidden corners of the city that larger vehicles cannot reach, you'll also make stops for photographs at the Socorro Viewpoint, to capture views of the stunning cliff tops and Santa Caterina Park, which provides exceptional views of the harbour below.

And after your unusual sightseeing experience, there'll be plenty of time to explore more of the sights and sounds of Funchal independently.

Cable Car & Monte Palace Gardens (Ref: FNC_025)

Madeira

The cable car takes you on a picturesque trip up to Monte, where the first image you see is the twin-towered façade of the 18th century church. The ride takes approximately 15 minutes. (The cable car access is similar to a ski lift. The car does not stop for boarding; it just slows in motion).

You continue to the tropical Monte Palace Gardens, with its excellent collection of trees and exotic plants from all over the world. The Gardens also have several lagoons and waterfalls where you will be able to marvel at the Koi Carp.

After the visit to the Gardens you'll travel to Pico do Barcelos, which offers a panoramic view of Funchal, the bay and surrounding hills.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach, cable car and on foot. The terrain at the Gardens is mostly uneven, with many steps and some steep slopes.

The Caves of São Vicente (Ref: FNC_037)

Madeira

Embark on a scenic drive along the south western coast of Madeira, before reaching the pretty secluded village of Serra de Agua, nestled within a lush green ravine. Enjoy a brief photo stop and a visit to a traditional bar to sample the local drink 'poncha' made from rum and honey!!!


Next, you'll head to São Vicente's Caves and Volcanism Centre, to explore the entrails of the earth. The caves are made up from a series of lava tubes that were formed during a volcanic eruption over 400 thousand years ago. Admire the volcanic stalactites, 'lava cakes' and the erratic block. Your cave exploration ends at the Volcanism Centre where you can enjoy a 3D film experience which allows you to relive Madeira's formation nearly 5 million years ago.

Before returning to Funchal, take advantage of some free time to capture the natural beauty and breathtaking scenery of São Vicente.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach and on foot. Passengers are advised to bring a jacket, as the temperature will be noticeably cooler underground. Footwear suitable for walking over rough, uneven and wet ground is essential. The caves can often become slippery and care should be taken. This tour includes approximately 1 hours' walking over some uneven and cobbled ground.

Scenes of Madeira (Ref: FNC_020)

Madeira

Your scenic extravaganza starts off along the rugged west coast road and through the picturesque fishing village of Camara de Lobos, once painted by Sir Winston Churchill. The beauty of Funchal is best admired from the Pico da Torre viewpoint.

Driving through eucalyptus forests, you will reach Cabo Girao. From a superb viewpoint, see the second highest sea cliff in the world. From here, you can also see mountain slopes that have been carved into terraces.

At Pico dos Barcelos the true beauty of the island is revealed. See Funchal in the distance and the surrounding villages scattered on green slopes.

An essential part of any visit to Madeira is experiencing its well-known wine. Enjoy sampling several different types of Madeira wine and take the opportunity to purchase a bottle to take home with you.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach. As coaches are not permitted to park outside the wine lodge, you are advised that a walk up a slope and some steps will be necessary. There are some cobblestones and steps at the viewpoints. This excursion involves traveling around hairpin bends with steep slopes, which may affect those who suffer from vertigo.

Santa Cruz Trolley Train & Walk (Ref: LPA_010)

La Palma

Hop aboard the 'trolley train' and enjoy a panoramic tour of the town, along Santa Cruz de La Palma's main avenue, Avenida Maritima. The hustle and bustle of this tiny capital will melt into the background as your guide narrates fascinating tales by way of wireless headsets.

Upon arrival at the Barco de la Virgen, a replica of Columbus' Santa Maria, it's time to stretch your legs and take a stroll. Discover the streets and squares including Plaza Alameda, Plaza San Francisco, and Placeta Borrero. Admire the attractive two-story Renaissance style Town Hall and the 17th century church, Iglesia del Salvador.

In the heart of Santa Cruz, you'll visit a traditional tapas bar to sample some of the local tapas dishes accompanied by a refreshing glass of wine, beer or a soft drink.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by trolley train and on foot. This tour involves up to 1½ hours of guided walking over cobblestones and uneven surfaces. Guests are advised to wear comfortable clothing and flat walking shoes.

Leisurely La Palma (Ref: LPA_018)

La Palma

Embark on a scenic panoramic drive to the west of the island and through the upper region of the Aridane Valley. The area is the highest point of the island and is also home to the charming town of El Paso. Upon arrival, a short stop will be made for you to enjoy the town's surroundings.


You will leave El Paso and take a short drive to the delightful La Glorieta Square. The square is the work of local artist, Luis Morera, who was once a pupil of César Manrique. Here, you can enjoy a photograph stop and view the unique and colourful mosaic floor, reminiscent of Manrique's designs found in Lanzarote.

Afterwards, you will head to the southern tip of La Palma and on to Fuencaliente. There will be some time to relax with a tea, coffee or soft drink refreshment at a local restaurant, before the return drive to the port.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach and on foot. This tour involves limited walking, however guests must be able to negotiate steps on to and off the coach. The drive involves some hairpin bends and is not suitable for those who suffer from vertigo.

The Heart of La Palma (Ref: LPA_002)

La Palma

Sit back and relax, as you embark on a scenic drive to Santuario Virgen de Las Nieves. Inside the small whitewashed church you will find the island's most sacred icon, the Virgin Mary of the Snows, the patron saint of the island.

Travelling through the mountain roads, which offer spectacular views, you will arrive at La Caldera de Taburiente. Designated a National Park, this particular volcanic crater is five miles wide and its rims reach right up to the mountain ridge that runs from the north to the south of the island. The crater was not actually formed as a result of volcanic activity, but from subsequent erosion, and it is forested with the exceptional fire-resistant Canary Pine.

Afterwards, take some time to relax and enjoy some local refreshments. On the way back, a brief photograph stop will be made at the viewpoint Mirador de la Concepcion, where you may admire the stunning views along the coast and to the north of the island.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach and on foot. There is an estimated 45 minutes of walking on this tour over rough and uneven ground. You are advised to wear appropriate footwear and carry a sweater or warm clothing as the wind can be cooler and stronger the higher you travel (depending on time of year). This tour is not recommended for guests suffering from vertigo. It is forbidden to remove any stones or plants from the National Park. Smoking is not permitted at the National Park, and there no toilets within the Park. In case of extremely high temperatures and/or strong winds, the National Park may deny access for safety reasons. If this occurs, the tour will be diverted to the village of Tazacorte, which offers views of the National Park.

Volcanoes & Wine (Ref: LPA_005)

La Palma

Drive through vineyards and lava streams passing pine trees and small villages towards the deep south - the area where the volcanoes take charge. Arriving at Fuencaliente, a famous wine-producing region, you will visit the San Antonio volcano. Here you may be able to walk over the crater border and stroll around the Visitor Centre.

A visit will be made to a typical bodega, where you will have the opportunity to sample some of the local red and white wines. You may also wish to purchase the wines that you have sampled.

A short drive brings you to the pottery centre of 'El Molino' in Mazo. Located in an old windmill, this pottery is unique to the Benahorita people, which is to this day lovingly reproduced. There is a gift shop for you to purchase those all-important souvenirs.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach. The walk near the volcanoes is over rough, gravelled ground and narrow, uneven paths with some inclines. Please follow your guide's instructions and do not venture near the edge of the walking trail, as there are no handrails or barriers. There are some steep inclines and steps at El Molino Pottery. Warm clothing and walking shoes are recommended. This tour is not recommended for guests suffering from vertigo. The walking at the Volcano is optional.

Island Discovery (Ref: LPS_028)

Gran Canaria

Your tour begins in the capital, Las Palmas, where you will drive through the city's old colonial area of Vegueta to visit the Museum of Columbus. After this interesting visit, you will then head off into the hills towards the Crater of Bandama. This is truly a magnificent sight, from where you can appreciate amazing panoramic views (weather permitting) and look out towards Spain's oldest golf course.

Continue to the Casa Del Vino where you will have the opportunity to purchase refreshments and visit the small museum. At the highest point on Gran Canaria, the 6,000 feet-high village of Tejeda, take in the marvellous views before enjoying luncheon at the El Refugio Restaurant.

After luncheon, your descent to the coast begins. En route, a stop will be made at the village of Teror to visit the basilica, home of the island's patron saint, 'Our Lady of the Pine'. From here, continue to the 'banana town' of Arucas with its imposing black cathedral, where a final highlight of your tour will be a visit to Gardens of the Duchess, a tropical paradise with flowers, plants and trees from many tropical and sub-tropical parts of the world. This full day tour will unveil the highlights of the island, enabling you to experience some real local culture along the way.

Essential Information

The tour involves approximately 45 minutes of walking over mainly flat and even ground. Teror can be extremely busy on Sundays, which may cause the tour duration to be lengthened. There are around 22 steps to negotiate at the entrance area to Marquesa's Garden and some additional steps within the garden. The terrain is a combination of gravel and paved surfaces. Flat, comfortable shoes are recommended.

Gran Canaria

The popular resort area of Maspalomas is home to the famous sand dunes that stretch as far as the eye can see. Upon arrival the time is yours to spend as you please, perhaps take a refreshing swim in the sea, browse the shops or simply explore the town.

Afterwards, you will take a drive to Puerto Mogan, Gran Canaria's smallest and southern most resort. Your independent time here can be spent exploring the shops, strolling along the harbour or by heading to the small beach for a swim.

Each resort offers plenty of cafés if you wish to purchase refreshments or luncheon.

After each visit, you will meet at the designated time and place to rejoin the coach.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate coach and on foot. This is an unguided transfer exclusive of refreshments, meals or entrance fees. Please note meeting points and return times as coaches cannot be held for latecomers. The travel time is around one hour each way, with around two hours at each resort. The drive to Puerto Mogan involves winding roads not suitable for those who suffer from vertigo. Walking is at guests' discretion. There are steps to negotiate on to and off the coach. Shops may be closed on Sundays and Bank Holidays. In Puerto Mogan there is a Friday market and coach parking is restricted, making the walk into town slightly further. Euros are accepted for purchases. If you wish to swim, please remember swimwear, a towel and sunscreen. Please refrain from drinking alcohol prior to swimming activities. There may be independent suppliers on the beaches that may offer water sports. These are provided by parties unconnected to Cunard.

Essence of Gran Canaria (Ref: LPS_008)

Gran Canaria

No visit to the island would be complete without seeing Gran Canaria's famous Bandama Crater. At the viewpoint, see stunning views of the north and east coast and look out towards the mountainous centre in the west. Travel to Teror, with its red-tiled, whitewashed houses, ornately carved balconies and charming patios hidden behind large wooden doors. This is an ideal place to shop for souvenirs, admire the architecture or visit the Church of Our Lady of the Pine, the patron saint of Gran Canaria.

Set among banana plantations is 'La Hacienda', the oldest country estate in all the Canary Islands, dating back to 1572. Sit back and relax as refreshments of tea, coffee, sandwiches and cakes are served while you admire wonderful views over the grounds - an astounding sea of green, which envelops the hacienda's sweeping ochre-brick buildings.

Delight in one last view of the harbour and the city at Altavista, before returning to the ship.

Submarine Dive (Ref: LPS_016)

Gran Canaria

After a coach transfer from Las Palmas to the south, you will have approximately an hour's free time in Puerto Mogan to wander around the 'little sister of Venice'. Although a modern resort, many come here to enjoy its old-fashioned Mediterranean atmosphere. Puerto Mogan is the island's most westerly resort and some say the loveliest, so enjoy some time in the bustling marina before embarking the submarine for your exclusive dive.

The submarine is fully air-conditioned, with a TV monitor for every two guests, comfortable seating and your very own porthole window for viewing. This unique underwater experience is a must for everyone!.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach and yellow submarine. Please be advised that there are no toilet facilities on board the submarine. Guests are advised that there is a ladder to get in and out of the vessel. The dive lasts approximately 35 - 45 minutes. The order of highlights may vary. There is a walk of approximately 20 minutes from the coach drop off point to the submarine.

Leisurely Gran Canaria (Ref: LPS_007)

Gran Canaria

Sit back and relax, as you embark on a panoramic drive, heading south towards the main resort of Playa del Ingles. A short photograph stop will be made for you to enjoy the wonderful Maspalomas sand dunes and surrounding coastline views.

Afterwards, you will continue to a pleasant viewpoint that overlooks the vibrant and modern resort of Puerto Rico. The resort has many holiday apartments built on the terraces of steep slopes that rise from the sea. A short photograph stop will be made for you to enjoy the panoramic view.

To round off your tour, a visit will be made to the smallest and most beautiful southern resort of Puerto Mogan. You will have around one hour of free time to explore this small, tranquil and friendly resort. Stroll along the harbour, shop for souvenirs or just simply relax in a little café and watch the world go by before returning to the ship.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach. In order to derive full enjoyment of this tour, some walking is required. Guests must be able to negotiate steps on to and off the coach. There is a market in Puerto Mogan on Fridays and coach parking is restricted, which will result in a further than usual walk to the main town. Euros are accepted for purchases. The drive will involve winding roads and is not a suitable option for those who suffer from vertigo. There are no designated comfort stops during this tour and you will need to use facilities in cafés and restaurants in Puerto Mogan if required.

Camel Ride and Fire Mountain (Ref: LAN_003)

Lanzarote

Great fun for all ages - hop aboard your dromedary camel, for a 30-minute camel ride. Travel in a camel-train over the volcanic dunes, reminiscent of the surface of the moon with lava formations and volcanic craters. Carved between the striking red and black lava fields is the snaking road which takes you to Fire Mountain. The geothermal experiments demonstrating the fearsome heat that bubbles below the surface, are a sight to behold. Finally, enjoy a little 'try and buy' as you sample one of the local wines at a 'bodega' in the La Geria wine region (please note that there is no seating inside and seating outside is limited).

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach and camel. Guests are advised to take a jacket as it may be windy up on Fire Mountain. Please note that the National Park is a popular tourist attraction and delays may be encountered on entrance. Sensible, closed toe, walking shoes are recommended. This tour travels along some winding mountain roads. The ground at Fire Mountain is sloping in parts. Participants in the wine tasting must be 18 years of age or over.

Hidden Lanzarote (Ref: LAN_020)

Lanzarote

As you travel northwards, enjoy a visit to the Monumento al Campesino, created by Cesar Marinque, and the small Casa Museum, an old restored farmhouse that holds a collection of implements used in past times. You will also enjoy a photograph stop at the Haria viewpoint, which offers breathtaking views of the northern headland and neighbouring islands.

Your journey will continue to the Aloe Vera Farm tucked away in the village of Orzola. Aloe vera is a typical plant of warmer regions and one that grows exceptionally well on the island of Lanzarote. The plant is used for a multitude of purposes, from preventing wound infection to being a valuable ingredient of skincare, it can even be taken orally. During your visit you will have the opportunity to try some aloe juice or liqueur.

Afterwards, you will head to Manrique's Jardin de Cactus, filled with over 1,500 cacti from more than 100 different species found in Lanzarote, America and Madagascar. The Garden is a stone-built enclosure and provides a stunning background for these unusual plants. It is also in this area that the cochineal beetle has been cultivated. The beetle lives on cacti and its larvae are used to produce the valuable red colourant, cochineal, formerly found in drinks such as Campari.


During your visit, enjoy some time to wander around the garden and relax with a refreshment at the on-site café, before the return drive to the port.

Discover the North (Ref: LAN_023)

Lanzarote

Your scenic drive through the extraordinary landscape of Lanzarote takes you north to visit the Monumento al Campesino, created by Cesar Marinque, and the small Casa Museum, an old restored farmhouse that holds a collection of implements used in past times.

A stop will be made at Haria, the capital of the municipality, characterised by beautiful landscapes, crystal clear waters and stunning view of the Valley of a Thousand Palms. Mirador de Guinate will offer you a spectacular viewpoint and, on a clear day, you will be able to see the island of La Graciosa.

The artist, Cesar Manrique, turned what was once a water hole in the earth's surface into an inspiring volcanic cavern and exotic subterranean water garden, Jameos del Agua. Follow the spiral stairs into a roofless cavern overlooking an underground lake. See if you can spot the tiny, blind white crabs that live in the perfectly transparent waters. A meandering path leads back to the surface where you will be greeted by a glistening crystal-blue pool.

This excursion will operate by coach and on foot. This tour involves many steep steps and some uneven, gravel ground. Comfortable non-slip shoes are recommended and a wrap or jacket for the caves.

Mountain of Fire (Ref: LAN_001)

Lanzarote

Fire Mountain was born from a spectacular volcanic eruption over 280 years ago. As you drive through the haunting scenery of dark, barren lava cinders topped by brooding ochre and violet volcano cones, you'll witness at close-hand, a lunar landscape whose images nourish the imagination. Have your camera ready, as a guide performs some amazing experiments to demonstrate the violent forces beneath the earth's crust, proving that the volcano is certainly not extinct, but only dormant.

Vineyards dot the landscape with the vines, protected by semi-circular stonewalls, making them look more like art than agriculture. A visit will be made to a 'bodega' for you to try one of the local wines.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach. Guests are advised to take a wrap or jacket with them, as it may be windy up on Fire Mountain. Please note that Fire Mountain National Park is a popular tourist attraction, which could result in delays on entrance. Comfortable, flat, closed toe, walking shoes are recommended. This tour travels along some winding mountain roads. The ground at Fire Mountain is sloping in parts.

Afterwards, drive down the famous avenue of Liberty to Rossio Square, to see the Santa Justa Elavator, designed by an apprentice of the famous Gustave Eiffel. Finally you will see the one of the most impressive squares in Lisbon the Praca co Comercio (Black Horse Square).

This is a great tour for those wishing to relax and enjoy a scenic tour of Lisbon.

Hailed by poets for the great beauty of its surrounding mountain range, Sintra Village is renowned for the view of the old Royal Palace, perched on the highest peak. One of Portugal's oldest settlements, occupied by both Moors and monarchs, whose castles and palaces add charm to the village. Enjoy free time to explore at your own pace.

Make the most of a photography stop at the Praia do Guincho and capture the magnificent views and the most westerly point in Europe – Cabo da Roca.

Cascais, originally an old Portuguese fishing village, has now become a popular holiday resort. Set alongside the picturesque Bay of Cascais, lovely early 20th century homes mingle with modern buildings, creating a delightful atmosphere. You will have some free time to wander along the streets, enjoy the views or browse in the local shops.

The return drive will be along the Corniche bordering the River Tagus, passing by the well-known village of Estoril.

This excursion will operate by coach and on foot. The streets of Sintra are steep and cobble-stoned, and care should be taken. Highlights may operate in reverse to that described above. Shops in Cascais are closed on Sundays and public holidays.

The final stop will be made in the heart of downtown Lisbon at 'Comercio Street'. A short walk will take you to Black Horse Square, the largest square in Lisbon that offers a variety of shops, restaurants and cafés. The bustling pedestrian street of 'Rua Augusta' is a popular meeting point for locals and visitors alike.

After each stop, you'll meet at a designated time and place to rejoin the coach.

To further enhance this Lisbon experience, you will step from ancient tram to modern coach as your tour is rounded off with a panoramic drive of the city's most famous monuments.

At the famous Black Horse Square, step aboard the tram for a leisurely circuit through this seven-hilled metropolis. See many fascinating glimpses of the 'old city' and the Tagus, passing landmarks such as the Parliament, Cathedral and Santa Luzia Belvedere. At Estrela Square, say goodbye to your traditionally-dressed waiters as you step onto a coach for the second part of your tour.

As you stand before the impressive Gothic-Manueline-style Jeronimos Monastery, your guide will provide you with details of this imposing building. Nearby, you will be equally impressed by the lavishly-decorated Belem Tower and the Monument to the Discoveries, which commemorate Henry the Navigator and Portugal's incredible voyages of exploration.

A panoramic tour will show you Lisbon's renowned landmarks, including Pombal Square, Liberty Avenue, Black Horse Square and Rossio, the very heart of the city. See Baixa, the area rebuilt after the city's disastrous earthquake, and take in the spectacular scene from the viewpoint at King Edward VII Park.

Remember your camera, as you will want to capture the charm of Lisbon when viewed from the water. As your river cruise sets off, you will see the medieval part of the city. Cruise beneath the spectacular suspension bridge, reminiscent of the Golden Gate and photograph the monumental statue of Christ the King. The highlight of your tour will be a sail along the banks of the Belem area, where ancient caravels once set off on great voyages of discovery. According to local lore, three peasant children from a nearby village observed a 'Lady of the Light' hovering above a small oak tree at the Cova Da Iraia (the cove of peace). This was believed to be the blessed 'Virgin Mary' and after returning on the same day for over five months, a miracle was said to have been written in the sky in front of over 70,000 witnesses. Today, many people from around the world make the famous pilgrimage to Fatima in search of the miracles.

Visit the famous Basilica with its spectacular stained-glass windows and paintings. Inside the Basilica you will see the resting place of the legendary three peasant children, Lucia Santos and her two cousins, Jacinta and Francisco Marto, at the Chapel of Apparitions.

Take some free time and enjoy luncheon on your own then browse some of the local shops for souvenirs.

Essential Information

This excursion will operate by coach and on foot. The journey to Fatima takes approximately 1¼ hours each way. There is approximately four hours of walking over flat ground on this tour, therefore comfortable non-slip shoes are recommended.

SAFETY ON EXCURSIONS

The provisions in the Booking Conditions (or 'Passage Contract' in the case of our US guests) and these terms and conditions govern Cunard's responsibility to guests in respect of shore excursions. Participation by a guest in shore excursions is conditional upon such guest's acceptance of such terms and conditions. Participation may also be subject to the independent tour operators' own terms and conditions. We will arrange for shore excursions to be performed by an independent local excursion provider. Cunard does not provide or supply the excursion services. We will exercise reasonable care and skill in selecting the excursion providers and require them to comply with all relevant local, national and /or international standards and legislation. The health, safety and comfort of our guests is paramount. We therefore require all shore excursion providers to have insurance and to have and to adhere to their own safety management systems. However, you should still take care for your own safety and that of any children there may be in your party. Shore excursions will operate in all weathers unless it is advised by the local provider that it is inappropriate or unsafe for the excursion to go ahead as planned. We want you to enjoy every aspect of your holiday so please read the information about the excursions very carefully and take reasonable precautions for your own safety and that of those in your party. Please ensure that you have read the *Guide to symbols and Important information* sections.

Please note that in relation to all excursions Cunard is not responsible or liable for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by you unless such loss, damage or injury arises out of a breach of legal duty of Cunard. Cunard will not in any circumstances have a greater liability than the excursion supplier and Cunard shall not be responsible for the negligent acts/omissions of the excursion supplier. Cunard will invoice you for all medical care given onboard and you will also be responsible for the cost of any hospital visits on land. Cunard assumes no responsibility or liability for any goods purchased while participating in a shore excursion. Any purchase ashore is solely between the guest and the vendor.

INSURANCE

The extent of insurance coverage in foreign countries varies widely and depends on their laws and customs. Cunard recommends to its US guests, and requires all other guests, to obtain your own insurance protection before leaving home against loss or damage to baggage and personal effects, trip cancellation and emergency evacuations, accidental death or injury, illness and medical expenses sustained or incurred in connection with your voyage. Cunard cannot assume liability for baggage or other personal effects lost or damaged while those items are in the custody of an airline, hotel or other service providers.

SHORE EXCURSION FARES

The prices for shore excursions are in U.S. Dollars and are subject to change without notice. Prices may vary by departure date and time and are capacity controlled. Since prices are likely to increase closer to departure, it pays to book early. Once you have booked and paid for your shore excursion the price will not change. Pre-booked shore excursions will be charged to a valid credit card prior to the start of your cruise. Charges for your excursions booked once the voyage has started will be added to your on board account. Tickets will be delivered to your cabin. The cancellation deadline for confirmed shore excursion bookings is generally 48 hours prior to the ship's arrival in port. The prices for shore excursions are charged per adult, per child and in some cases per vehicle. Some shore excursions have a minimum age to participate, which is either set out in the tour description or will be made known to you when booking. In most circumstances the child prices shown apply to children aged 3 to 12 inclusive on the date of sailing, for those excursions deemed suitable for children. Children over the age of 12 will require adult tickets. Infants aged 2 and under on the date of sailing can travel on the excursion free of charge, as long as they are seated on your lap. However, there may be occasions when this information changes. In these cases notes have been added to the excursion descriptions. Please ensure that you book a tour ticket for your infant.

Note that all minors (those under 18) must be accompanied by an adult on shore excursions.

TOUR TIMINGS & ITINERARIES

The published duration for each excursion is approximate and the departure time on your tour tickets is the time that the last vehicle will leave. Prior to arrival in each port of call, the departure time of each excursion will be confirmed in the ship's programme. Timings are subject to change,

should the arrival time at any port be delayed, or the itinerary for any particular excursion be amended. The order of advertised sites within the shore excursion description may vary, and itineraries may operate in reverse order to that described. Please bear in mind that at some ports of call it will be necessary to walk some distance to reach your mode of transport. The ranges of excursions on offer are dependent on the ship and the date of the call in port.

WAITLISTED SHORE EXCURSIONS

Many shore excursions have limited availability and to avoid disappointment we recommend that you book excursions in advance of sailing. Shore excursions are processed on a first-come, first-served basis, and if the excursion you are interested in is sold out, you may add your name to our waitlist on line through Voyage Personaliser.

Should waitlisted shore excursions become available before your voyage departs, we will notify you by email. At that time, a booking will be created in your name and you will have 72 hours from the date the email is received in which to return to Voyage Personaliser and confirm your acceptance of the excursion and complete your purchase. If you do not return to Voyage Personaliser within 72 hours, the booking that has been created in your name will be cancelled. If you have chosen to waitlist more than one guest on an excursion, you will only be notified if enough spaces become available to fulfil the complete booking.

We recommend that you take some time to check the waitlisted shore excursion booking that has been created for you since the departure time and price of the shore excursion may vary from your original request. After voyage departure, any outstanding waitlists will be cleared on board if spaces are available and charges applied to your onboard account.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

You may cancel or amend the majority of reserved excursions at no cost online through Voyage Personaliser or by phoning Reservations up to **3** days in advance of sailing. There may, however, be shore excursions that are non refundable or incur a cancellation penalty or have an earlier cancellation deadline; details of this will be contained in the tour description.

(i) Pre-paid shore excursion bookings

Once on board, if you wish to cancel your shore excursions before the cancellation deadline (generally 48 hours prior to the arrival in port) a 10% cancellation fee will be applied to your onboard account and the full amount paid will be refunded to your original credit/debit card.

We regret that we are unable to refund the cost of excursions that are cancelled by guests after the cancellation deadline. If you do wish to cancel your shore excursion after the cancellation deadline we will credit the original credit /debit card with the full amount paid, however a 100% cancellation fee will be posted to your onboard account. In order to process any cancellations, tickets must be returned to the onboard Tour Office.

(ii)Shore excursion bookings made on board

If you wish to cancel your shore excursion before the cancellation deadline (generally 48 hours prior to the arrival in port) you should return your tickets to the Tour Office where a 10% cancellation fee will be applied to your onboard account. We regret that we are unable to refund the cost of excursions booked on board that are cancelled by guests after the cancellation deadline.

All shore excursions require a minimum participation, which if not achieved, may mean the excursion will be cancelled. In this event an alternative may be offered. We reserve the right to cancel or amend shore excursions prior to commencement for any other reason, including upon operational or commercial grounds, in which case we will make any refunds to your credit/ debit card if booked in advance or your onboard account if booked on board. Should any excursion have to be abandoned or amended after setting off, the best possible onboard credit will be arranged according to the circumstances.

PRIVATE TOUR TRANSPORT

If you wish to hire a car, book a private driver and guide for the day, or arrange a private tour for a small group at any of our ports of call, please contact the Tour Office on board at least 48 hours in advance of the call date. Separate terms and conditions apply to these bookings and these will be advised by the Tour Manager onboard before you confirm the booking. If you decide to cancel once the booking has been made, any cancellation fees incurred will be charged to your on board account.

TRANSPORTATION

Cunard arranges the best reasonably available means of transportation and local guides. In some countries, the best equipment and guides available may not be up to the same standards available at home; standards of transport vary considerably throughout the world. Air conditioned coaches are not available in some countries, whilst in others local buses are the best that can be provided. Cars or taxis are also used at some ports where coach or bus transportation is not available or limited. Guests are asked to take care when boarding or disembarking vehicles

particularly bearing in mind that some vehicles have high steps. All airline space used in touring is economy class unless otherwise specified. Guests wishing to travel together should all meet for the excursion together as this will help the Tour Staff to allocate them space in the same vehicle.

For the comfort of all quests, smoking is not permitted aboard any sightseeing vehicle. Guests are also requested to switch off mobile telephones.

MOBILITY

Guests unable to board a coach by the steps or who are unable to transfer into a standard car should contact the Shore Mobility Advisor by sending an email to the following address: . The Shore Mobility Advisor will be able to provide advice and assistance in arranging private, tailor made tours in adapted vehicles*, dependent on availability.(*Adapted vehicles used are those which are deemed suitable by Cunard.) Guests unable to board a coach by the steps and who are able to transfer into a standard car (provided the wheelchair is a suitable size to be stored in the boot of the car) should email for assistance in arranging a private car. Alternatively contact Reservations or the Tour Office on board. Guests who are able to board a coach by the steps are referred to the shore excursion descriptions, which are set out to offer practical advice based on Cunard's operating experience. Generally, full size coaches are able to accommodate small, collapsible scooters and /or manual wheelchairs (a limited number per coach). The coach driver is, however, unable to assist with the loading of scooters or wheelchairs into the vehicle. Where minibuses / trolley trains are used to operate shore excursions, the storage space is insufficient to be able to accommodate wheelchairs or scooters. You are strongly advised to read the excursion description to ensure that your chosen excursion is suitable for your individual personal requirements. Further advice on the suitability of excursions is available from the Tour Office on board. Taxis are usually available for hire close to the ship's berth should guests wish to travel independently. Guests who use a wheelchair and those who are not fully mobile may be restricted from going ashore at ports where launches are necessary.
